

## The Ann Silverman Community Health Clinic at St. John the Baptist

Our parish and The Lord's Pantry host a weekly free health clinic. We operate as a satellite location of the Ann Silverman Community Health Clinic that serves low-income uninsured or underinsured adults and children throughout Central and portions of Upper Bucks County.

Hours are:

First Monday: 3 to 5 p.m.

Second, Third and Fourth Thursdays: 9:30 to 11 a.m.

Patients are provided with one free medical appointment if a screening by staff indicates that the person meets the clinic's eligibility requirements. The next step is an eligibility appointment.

Additional services – such as medications, testing and dental and specialist visits – are provided at no charge if eligibility is approved. Eligibility is reviewed every six months or when the patient's circumstances change.

Every effort is made to assist patients in finding the best and most affordable alternatives for their healthcare, including applications for free or low-cost health insurance.
